

The Frank J. Williams & Electia Love Foundation High School HBCU Scholarship Application Form

The recipient of the HBCU scholarship will receive a one-time payment of \$1,000.00.

Applicant Criteria: The Frank J. Williams & Electia Love Foundation High School HBCU Scholarship is open to graduating seniors from any high school in the River Region (Autauga, Elmore, and Montgomery) who intend to enroll in an HBCU (Historically Black College or University). The HBCU can be either a four-year or two-year institution. Upon selection, the chosen student will receive half of the scholarship award. The remaining half will be granted upon submission of documentation proving enrollment and attendance at the chosen HBCU. Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale and provide proof of acceptance from the HBCU.

Eligible to receive this scholarship if you meet the above criteria, please submit the following information for this Application Form:

1. Official transcript- Your transcript can be mailed to the Scholarship Committee Chairman or included with your packet in a separate **sealed envelope**.
2. A letter of recommendation from your principal, school counselor, or teacher.
3. A letter of recommendation from a community leader, excluding school personnel.
4. Resume-Include community service activities, employment, and organizations that demonstrate leadership skills.
5. Essay: One page - Typed and double-spaced - Times New Roman -12-point font - Purpose - Body – Conclusion. Student must also provide a short statement (100 words minimum) on **“Why I chose to Attend a HBCU.”**
6. Proof of acceptance of to an HBCU.

If mailing, you must submit one (1) original and one (1) copy of your entire application package. This includes the above six items and this application.
